

Stained-Glass Windows

Materials: 1 piece of black construction paper, 2 pieces of clear contact paper, and tissue papers. There are 2 pieces of construction paper and 4 pieces contact paper in your bag/envelop so that you can make two of these, or so you can practice first and then make your masterpiece.

- 1 Cut the middle part of the black construction paper so that you have a frame.
- 2 Peel one piece of clear contact paper and put on a table so that the sticky side is up.
- 3 Put your frame onto the sticky contact paper. Put it in the middle of the sticky so that the entire frame is on the sticky. There will be overhang of sticky.
- 4 Tear tissue paper into small pieces, put onto the sticky paper, and make a scene like in a church or a modern design. You can use small, skinny strips of the black paper you cut out of the frame to make more inside borders if you want. Cover the entire inside the frame.

Consider making the scene on your table first and then putting it on the sticky paper.

- 5 Peel the other piece of clear contact paper and place it sticky side down covering your entire design and frame.
- 6 Trim the extra contact paper off along the edge of your frame. Hang on a window to let the light shine through.
